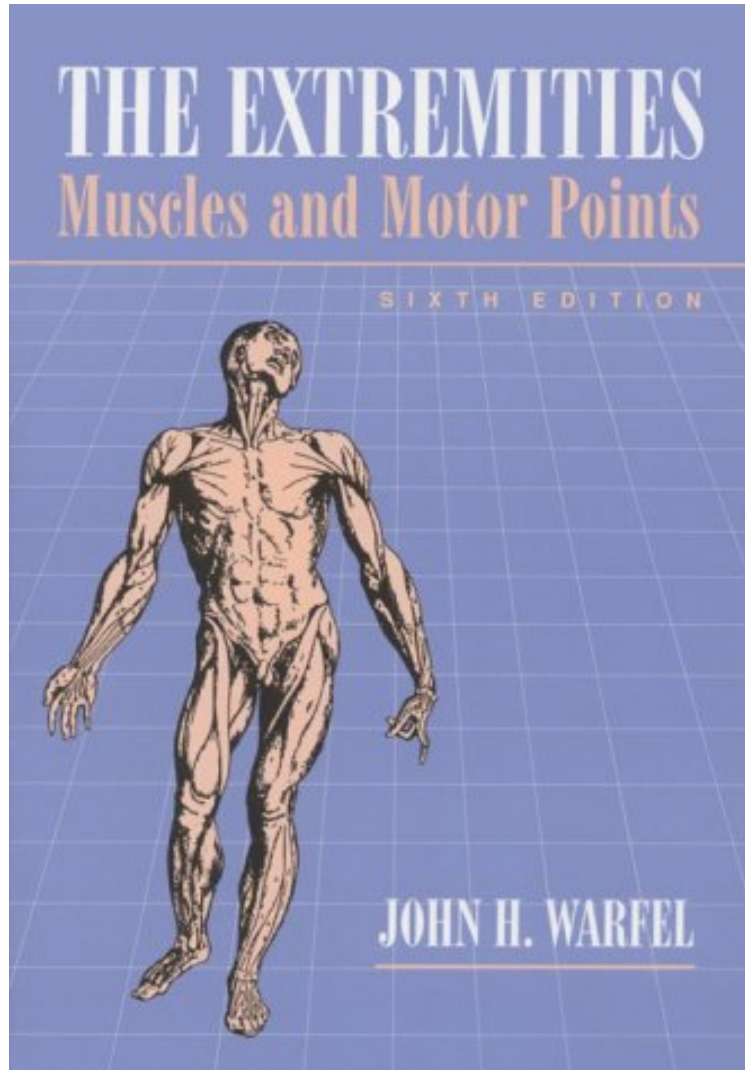

The pictures are very simple and do not show the many of the surrounding structures, or even allow for the depth of the muscle. The motor points are a simple dot in the picture, there is no description on how to locate it. These books do give the origin, insertion, nerve and artery information, but I am sure that could be found elsewhere and alongside other helpful information. I would highly suggest finding another book to get this (and other) information.

This book presents diagrammatic representation and condensed description of the complex relationship between muscles and motor points of the extremities. The style of presentation is identical to the companion volume, "The Head, Neck and Trunk", 5th ed, also by Warfel. The book is aimed at paramedics and physical education students.
