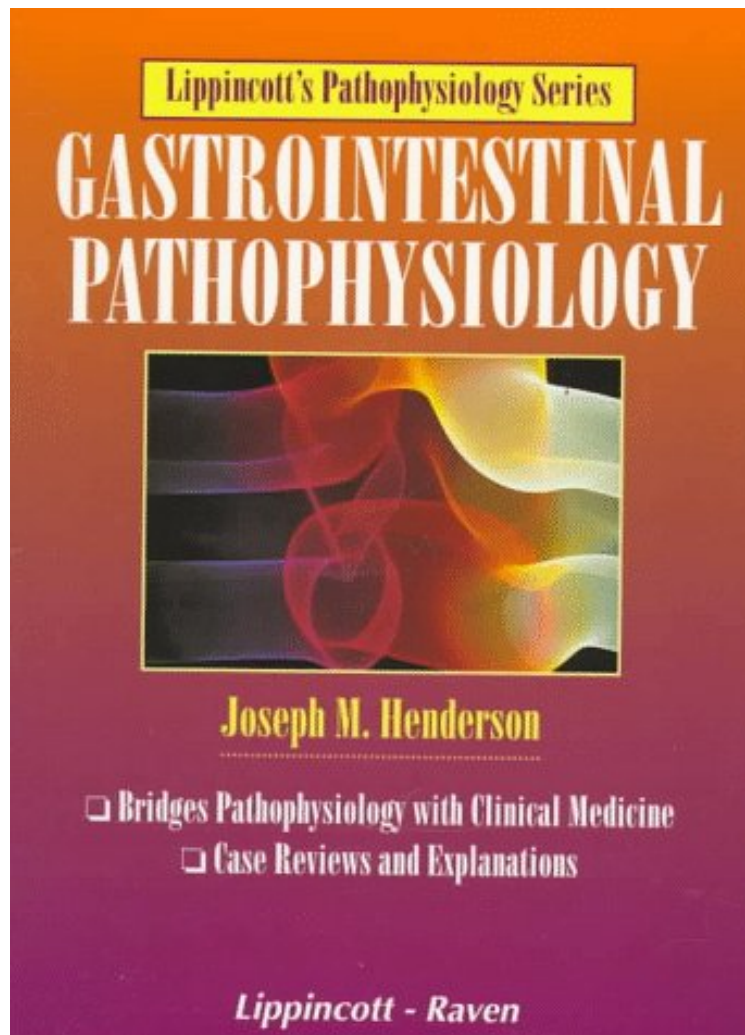

The book is organized nicely, and covers all of the major

gastrointestinal disease. The book also contains case presentations, which make the material more clinically applicable. The only drawback to this book is that certain sections are thin. For example, the chapter on GERD is very brief. In contrast, the chapter on diarrhea is quite long, detailed, and excellent.

This complete review of gastrointestinal pathophysiology provides the basis for understanding common gastrointestinal diagnostics and therapeutics. Clinical problems are used to emphasize the relation of pathophysiologic concepts to clinical medicine.
