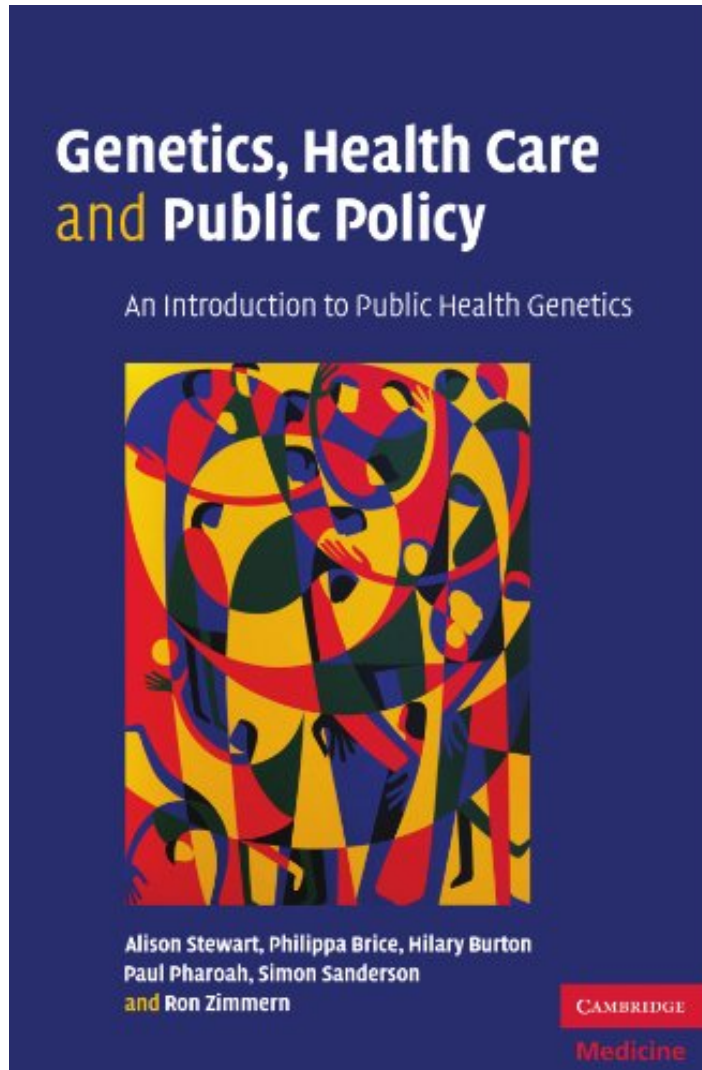


# Genetics, Health Care and Public Policy: An Introduction to Public Health Genetics
