**How To Build A Code For Diabetes**  
 Choose a number from each column until you reach a **green** box, at which point the code is complete. Valid codes may have four characters (E11.9), or as many as six (E11.331). Codes in **red** boxes represent additional diagnoses that may be required to complete reporting of a condition. Use additional code to identify any insulin use (Z79.4).
