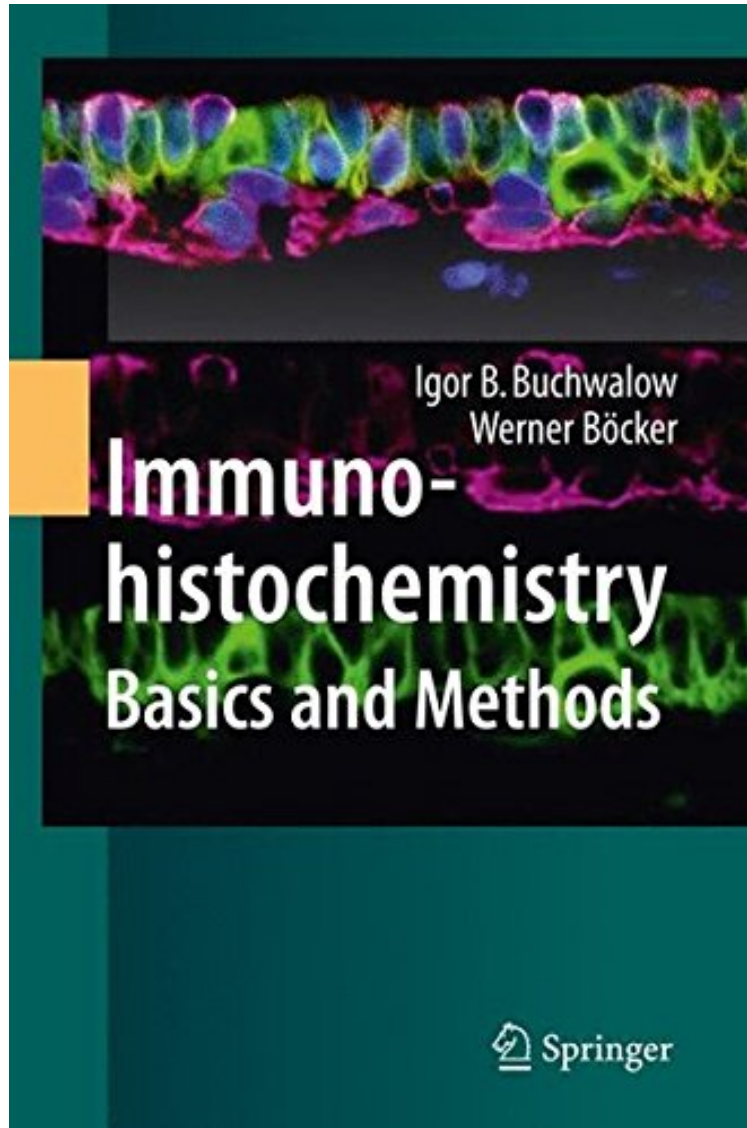

If I had to complain about something it would be that only very sparse attention was paid to antigen unmasking and there was no protocol. I would recommend this text to anyone with no to mid-level experience with IHC. The text is very well done.
