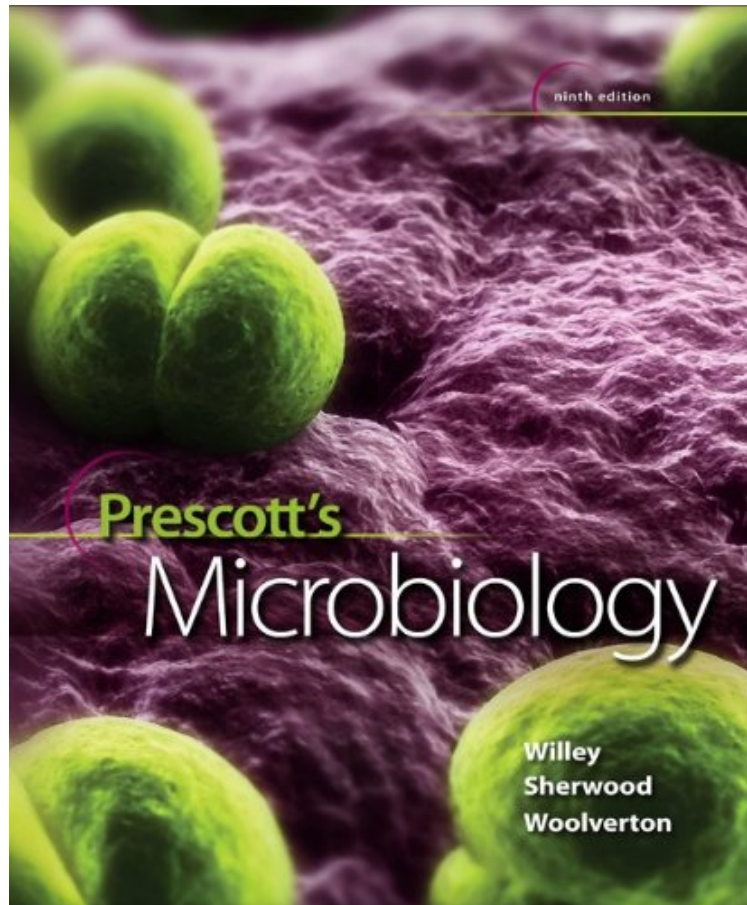

The cover of the package matched the 9th edition cover of the advertised product. When I opened the plastic wrap, a few separate documents were included: pronunciation guide for microorganisms (nice), intro to ConnectPlus (okay), ad for LearnSmart (not interested) and a Brief Contents of the Nine Parts, 43 Chapters of the 9th edition. The actual loose leaf text was the 8th edition not organized into Nine Parts, and has only 27 Chapters. According to the 9th ed contents, it is 200 pages longer than the 8th ed. This is NOT what I thought I had purchased and now since I unwrapped it, I'm not sure I can

return it. I've purchased many hard soft cover texts from in the past without any problems at all. This was my 1st loose leaf version purchase. My course syllabus is for the 43 Chapters. I now have to play the matching game between the 2 editions. Besides getting the wrong edition, many of the pages are stuck together.
