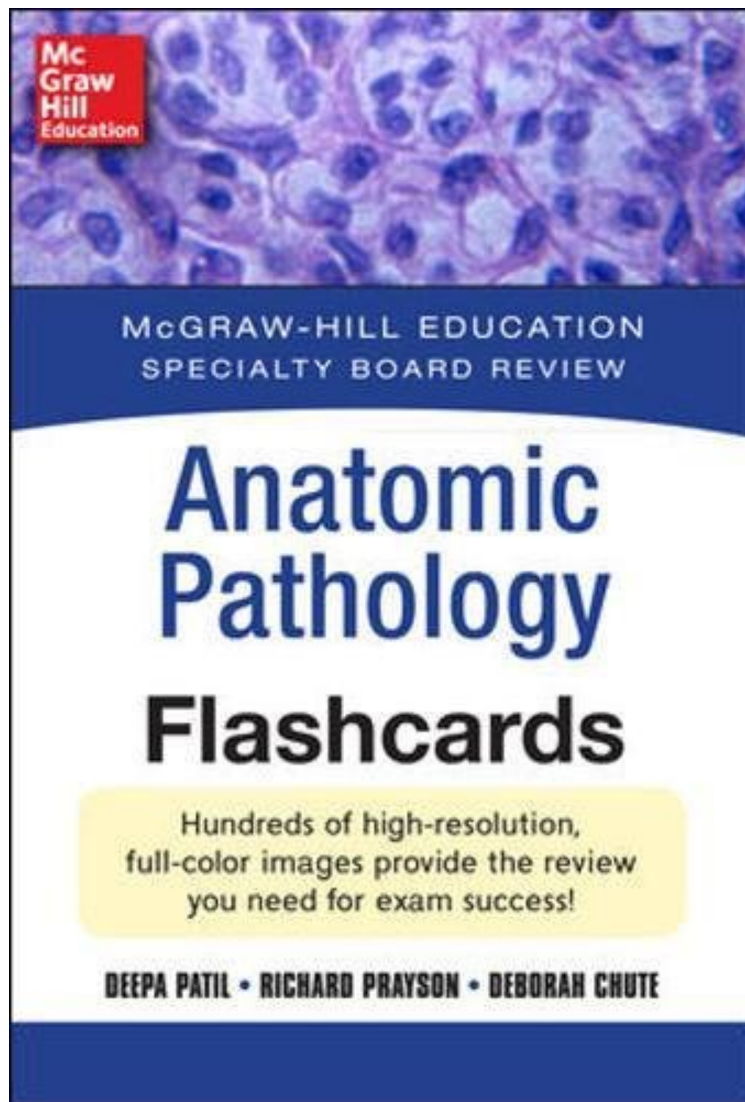

It seems they are all relatively straight forward with only high yield facts on the back. These cards are likely good for the MOC exams, but I find them a bit too light for boards studying. Some pictures are taken at low power and a diagnosis might be difficult to reach, but you will get a little history and you will be able to figure out a differential diagnosis. I think they are very handy if you can't carry a book around and want to review while you're on the bus/train, waiting around or taking a small break.
