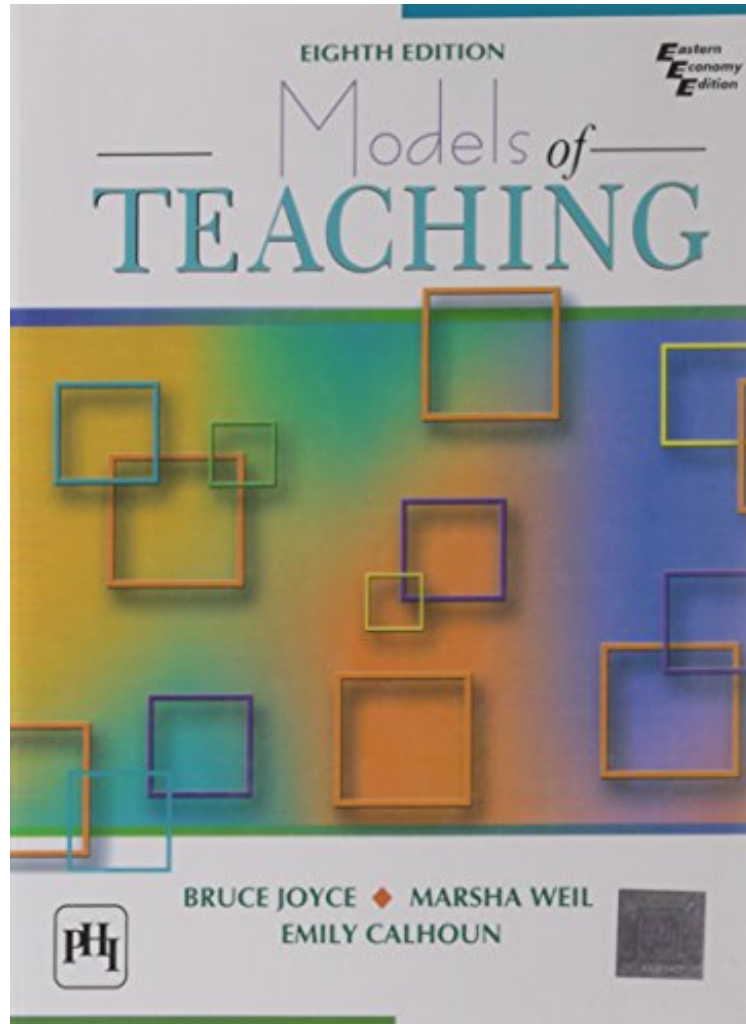

By GKI enjoyed studying Bruce Joyce's Models of Teaching. Part One felt a bit long-winded but, overall, the strategy of dividing the models of teaching into "families" is a good structure. Each family addresses how academic learning is best gained. The teaching models in part two focus on the intellect, in part three focus on social engagement and cooperation, in part four focus on developing individual esteem and responsibility, and in part five focus on responses to environment. I appreciate how Joyce repeatedly states how no one model should be used. Some models are appropriate at some times but not at all times. It is important to vary the manner and strategies we use when teaching. Good book.
